## CSIR-NORTH-EAST INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY (CSIR-NEIST)

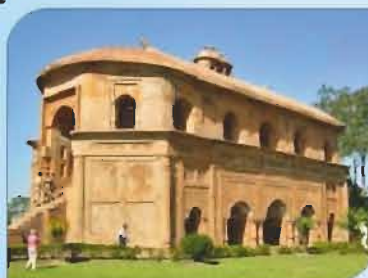

**Ahom architecture at Sivasagar:** Sivasagar, 50 Km from Jorhat, embodies the history of 600 years Ahom rule in Assam. The recreation centre of the Ahom kings called Ranghar, the palaces called Karengghar and Talatalghar, various temples called 'Dol' and huge artificial tanks from where the word 'Sagar', means sea, was derived are the main tourist attractions.



**Majuli:** Majuli, one of the World's biggest River-Islands, located in the District of Jorhat, is the centre of vaishnavite culture and philosophy in Assam, also called as cultural capital of the state. The monasteries called Satras established by great Vaishnavite saint and reformist Sankardeva, the migratory birds, lifestyle of local tribes are attraction of Majuli.
